Dear Sir,

This with reference to the notification issued of NO ENTRY on Ghodbunder road and subsequent meeting with D.C.P. Traffic Shri Dabhade on 26th April 2010 and joint road serve along with A.C.P. and Inspectors.

We from our association are of opinion that the no entry implemented cannot be justified at all. The implication of time required for traveling and extra expense for diversion is so high that can cripple our business. Also the delay in delivering Export consignment is affecting national trade.

As per our request to restore the timing pattern, upon serve it was clearly indicated that the road in timings from 1 P.M. to 5 P.M. in underutilized. Also the traffic congestion can be avoided taking some minor steps and proper regulation.

Overall we from our association strongly condemn the notification force on us without taking our consideration and request you to withdraw the same within seven days.

We from our side have always extended our support to you and hope that you will understand our trade's difficulty and help us to survive.
